Recent Updates:

- **TSCA Inventory Update:** As of January 17, 2025, the TSCA Inventory contains 86,847 chemicals, of which 42,495 are active in U.S. commerce.
- **PFAS Reporting Requirements:** On October 11, 2023, the EPA published the TSCA Reporting and Recordkeeping Requirements for Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS), effective from November 13, 2023. This rule mandates that PFAS manufacturers and importers report-specific information to the EPA by May 8, 2025.
