



TPP REACH Compliance Statement

The REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 is intended to enhance the protection of human health and the environment from risks posed by chemicals. The European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) continuously evaluates substances that may have serious effects on human health or the environment.

Substances that meet one or more of the criteria outlined in Article 57 of REACH are classified as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) and are placed on the Candidate List for Authorization, which is regularly updated. The current Candidate List is publicly available at the ECHA website: <http://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>. Identification as an SVHC and placement on the Candidate List represent the first step in the REACH authorization process. One of the key objectives of REACH is to encourage the substitution of hazardous substances with safer alternatives wherever feasible.

REACH also applies to laboratory equipment and materials considered “articles”, requiring manufacturers, suppliers, and importers to control and communicate the presence of SVHCs. In accordance with Article 33, suppliers must provide sufficient information along the supply chain to enable safe use of articles. If an SVHC is present in a concentration greater than 0.1% by weight, suppliers are obligated to disclose at least the substance’s name to downstream users.

TPP Techno Plastic Products AG rigorously monitors REACH requirements to ensure full compliance. This includes:

- Providing supply chain information on potential SVHCs;
- Evaluating alternatives to hazardous substances where applicable;
- Promptly updating our REACH compliance statements in accordance with the latest ECHA developments.

TPP remains committed to transparency, product safety, and environmental responsibility, ensuring that our products meet or exceed all applicable regulatory standards.
