### Recent Updates

- TSCA Inventory: As of January 17, 2025, the TSCA Inventory includes 86,847 chemicals, of which 42,495 are active in U.S. commerce.
- PFAS Reporting Requirements: On October 11, 2023, the EPA published the TSCA Reporting and Recordkeeping Requirements for Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS), effective November 13, 2023. This rule requires manufacturers and importers of PFAS to submit specific information to the EPA by May 8, 2025.

TPP remains fully committed to complying with all TSCA requirements, including these recent updates, and continuously monitors regulatory developments to maintain compliance.
